




D-I New York Beauty Arc foundation. Make 6 copies.




D-2 New York Beauty Arc foundation. Make 6 copies.




E New York Beauty Outer Band foundation. Make I copy.




F New York Beauty Outer Background template. Make I copy.




G Palm Left foundation. Make 6 copies.

New York Beauty Blocks

While appearing complex, this block is actually easy and fun to sew. The key is to pay close attention to the numbered order marked on the foundation on which 6 fabrics are sewn together for this arc.

Using the D-1 and D-2 New York Beauty arc foundations, start with a D1 background piece and add a D2 piece. Add a D3 piece and continue sewing in order until the arc is completed. As you sew, compare figures 1 and 2 with your work to help develop the design correctly (Figs. 1 and 2).

Trim each arc on the outside cutting line and carefully remove the paper foundation.

Pair a D-1 arc with a D-2 arc and sew them together to join the D6 section to the D9 section. Press the seam toward the D9 section. Make 6 D-1/D-2 arcs.

Lay out a block using an a New York Beauty center, a B New York Beauty inner band, a C New York Beauty middle band, a D-1/D-2 arc, and an E New York Beauty outer band (Fig. 3). Sew them together.

Press the seam between the A center and the B inner band toward the A center. Press the seam between the B inner band and the C middle band toward the B band. Press the seam between the C middle band and the D-1/D-2 arc toward the C middle band. Press the seam between the D-1/D-2 arc and the E outer band toward the E outer band. Make 6 blocks (Fig. 4).

Add the F New York Beauty outer backgrounds to 2 of the arcs (Fig. 5). These blocks will be used at the top and the bottom of the quilt.


